



Remote Deposit Capture Minimum System Requirements

To use Remote Deposit Capture, you must use a computer that meets the minimum system requirements. While Remote Deposit Capture may run on other configurations, we cannot provide customer support for issues experienced on configurations that do not meet these specifications:

PC: Windows Operating System

- Microsoft Windows 10 and Microsoft Windows 11.
- Windows Operating Systems include both 32-bit and 64-bit versions.
- All Windows operating systems should have the Microsoft recommended security updates from the Windows Update Center.
 - 1 GB of memory
 - Up to 268 MB of free hard drive space depending on the type of scanner used
 - USB 2.0
 - .NET 4.6.2 or higher

Mac: Macintosh Operating System

- Mac OS 10.15 Catalina*; Mac OS 11.0 Big Sur*; Mac OS 12.0 Monterey*; Mac OS 13.0 Ventura*.
**Supports the Merchant Capture Contemporary user interface only.*
 - USB 2.0
 - 1 GB of memory
 - Up to 268 MB of free hard drive space depending on the type of scanner
 - Currently, only Panini VisionX and Panini I:Deal scanners are qualified for use on a Mac.

- To install the software in Windows, you must run the scanner installation process and browser as a local administrator. This must be done during the first image capture to allow the system to place the required dll files in the correct folder.
